

As provided by §551.071 of the Texas Government Code, the Board of Trustees may conduct an executive session to seek the advice of its attorney and/or on a matter in which the duty of the attorneys under the Rules of Professional Conduct clearly conflict with the Open Meetings Act. The Board may seek or receive its attorney's advice on other legal matters during this executive session.
