The Chancellor recommends the following revisions to local policies to align College District admission and entrance requirements with the current centralized admissions process.

FB – Admissions	Revisions would revise local policy to remove language no longer applicable to the College District’s current admissions process, including but not limited to language that contemplates transfer to and/or enrollment in the “colleges” of the College District.

**Admission and
Entrance
Requirements**

~~Applications for admission shall be processed by the individual colleges. The College District shall not maintain a centralized admissions office nor prescribe attendance zones for individual colleges. Admissions procedures developed by the colleges shall ensure that the open door philosophy of the College District is implemented and that transfers between College District colleges and multiple enrollments in College District colleges are facilitated. Admission to the College District ~~colleges~~ shall be based on FB(LEGAL) and the following:~~

**Right to an
Academic Fresh
Start**

In keeping with Education Code 51.529, any state resident may elect not to have the ~~college~~ College District utilize college credits on courses that are ten years old or older. Should a student elect this option, no college courses or credits ten years old or older shall be evaluated for credit. A student may not selectively choose courses ten years old or older to be transferred into the ~~college~~ College District. This provision does not relieve students from notifying the college of attendance at previous institutions nor of the need to submit transcripts indicating all previous coursework attempted. Students electing this option must notify the ~~office~~ Office of ~~the registrar~~ Admissions upon submission of admission application.
