The Software Application Specialist Certificate provides a benchmark for students to measure their computer skills using Microsoft Office software. Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Certifications which provide students valuable credentials and a competitive edge is available for those who master required competencies. Courses that complete the Software Application Specialist Certificate are noted below.

Students pursuing this certificate are waived from the <u>Texas Success Initiative (TSI)</u> standards, but must meet course prerequisites.
