This is an example course sequence for students interested in pursuing Diagnostic Medical Sonography. It does not represent a contract, nor does it guarantee course availability. Following this pathway will help you earn an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in Diagnostic Medical Sonography. Students must earn at least 25% of the credit hours (15 hours) required for graduation through instruction by Dallas College. See catalog for official degree requirements.

The Diagnostic Medical Sonography program is a two-year A.A.S. degree program with a <u>competitive</u> <u>admissions process</u>. The Diagnostic Medical Sonographer performs sonography examinations using high frequency sound waves to visualize soft tissue structures, including the gall bladder, kidneys, pregnant uterus and other organs as requested by the physician. The Diagnostic Medical Sonographer may work in hospitals, clinics and physicians' offices. Courses that complete the degree are noted below.

Completion of one of the following:

- 2. Two years' employment as a healthcare worker within a medical related laboratory <u>AND</u> Direct patient care experience within the last 5 years
- 3. Current credential in a healthcare profession (e.g., RN, Medical Assisting, Radiography, Paramedic, LVN, etc.)

Exemptions/waivers may exist.

BIOL 2401 – Anatomy and Physiology I This is a Core course. Prior to registration you must earn A grade of "C" or better in BIOL 1406.
