Students must earn at least 25% of the credit hours required for graduation through instruction by Dallas College. See catalog for official certificate requirements.

The Theatrical Costuming Certificate prepares the student for an entry-level job in a theatrical costume workshop. Courses that complete the certificate are noted below.

Students pursuing this certificate are waived from the <u>Texas Success Initiative (TSI)</u> standards, but must meet course prerequisites, as long as the student completes the TSI waiver form prior to enrollment.
