This award is designed to prepare students for positions of leadership within a business/administrative/management environment. Emphasis will be placed on entry-level supervisory skills, team development and on-the-job training.

Students pursuing this certificate are waived from the [Texas Success Initiative \(TSI\)](#) standards, but must meet course prerequisites, as long as the student completes the TSI waiver form prior to enrollment.
