Students must earn at least 25% of the credit hours required for graduation through instruction by Dallas College. Visit the catalog for official certificate requirements.

This award is designed to prepare students for positions of leadership within a business/administrative/ management environment. Emphasis will be placed on entry-level supervisory skills, team development and on-the-job training.

Students pursuing this certificate are waived from the <u>Texas Success Initiative (TSI)</u> standards, but must meet course prerequisites, as long as the student completes the TSI waiver form prior to enrollment.
