The International Business and Trade Skills Achievement Award for the International Business and Trade Associate of Applied Science Degree, International Business and Trade Certificate, the Import-Export Certificate provides specific skills in language training recommended by business and industry. Certification is available in the following languages: Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Portuguese, Russian, and/or Spanish. Courses that complete the International Business and Trade SA Award are noted below.

Students pursuing this certificate are waived from the <u>Texas Success Initiative (TSI)</u> standards, but must meet course prerequisites, as long as the student completes the TSI waiver form prior to enrollment.
