Students must earn at least 25% of the credit hours (15 hours) required for graduation through instruction by Dallas College. See catalog for official degree requirements.

The International Business and Trade Program prepares students to enter the global business space in a variety of areas like transportation, customer service, compliance and import and export. Courses that complete the degree, the Import-Export Certificate (IE) and International Business and Trade Certificate (IB) are noted below.
