Students must earn at least 25% of the credit hours required for graduation through instruction by Dallas College. See catalog for official certificate requirements.

The International Business and Trade Program prepares students to enter the global business space in a variety of areas like transportation, customer service, compliance and import and export. An International Business and Trade Import-Export Certificate will expedite your entrance to the international arena. Courses that complete the International Business and Trade Import-Export Certificate are noted below.

Students pursuing this certificate are waived from the <u>Texas Success Initiative (TSI)</u> standards, but must meet course prerequisites, as long as the student completes the TSI waiver form prior to enrollment.
