

GUIDED PATHWAY: PHYSICAL EDUCATION (EARLY CHILDHOOD – 12 CERTIFICATION)

This guided pathway prepares you to transfer to a university to earn a bachelor's degree in Kinesiology that prepares you to become a Physical Education teacher, coach, or enter athletic administration for any grade between Early Childhood and 12th.

This pathway is an example course sequence for students interested in Physical Education and Kinesiology. It does not represent a contract, nor does it guarantee course availability. Following this pathway will help you earn an Associate of Arts degree. Students must earn at least 25% of the credit hours (15 hours) required for graduation through instruction by Dallas College. DEGREE MINIMUM: 60 SEMESTER CREDIT HOURS

SEMESTER 1 Total Hours: 16

ENGL 1301 – Composition I This is a Core course. Must earn a grade of "C" or higher.

HIST 1301 – United States History I This is a Core course.

MATH 1342 - Elementary Statistical Methods* This is a Core course. Must earn a grade of "C" or higher.

KINE 1301 - Foundations of Kinesiology*

PHED 1164 - Introduction to Physical Fitness and Wellness* This is a Core course.

EDUC 1300 – Learning Framework All college students with fewer than 12 semester credit hours of successful college credit (grade of "C" or above) must take a student success course in the first semester.

SEMESTER 1 ACTION ITEMS

- 1. Meet with your advisor to confirm your academic and career goals by the end of the semester.
- 2. Meet with a career advisor/coach to research career options with a degree in Kinesiology.
- Begin researching colleges and universities where you would want to major in Kinesiology with grades EC-12 Certification.

SPCH 1315 – Public Speaking* This is a Core course. OR

SEMESTER 2 ACTION ITEMS
