This is an example course sequence for students interested in pursuing the Substance Abuse Counseling – Mental Health/Substance Abuse Prevention Certificate. It does not represent a contract, nor does it guarantee course availability. Following this pathway will help you earn the Mental Health/Substance Abuse Prevention Level I Certificate. Courses from this certificate may apply to the related A.A.S. degree. Students must earn at least 25% of the credit hours required for graduation through instruction by Dallas College. See catalog for official certificate requirements.

The Mental Health/Substance Abuse Prevention Certificate is designed to provide cross-training for helping professionals in the faith-based communities and the social services agencies. Completers of the 18 hours will be granted the Mental Health/Substance Abuse Prevention Certificate focusing on Co-Occurring Disorders. Courses that complete the Mental Health/Substance Abuse Prevention Certificate are noted below.

Students pursuing this certificate are waived from the <u>Texas Success Initiative (TSI)</u> standards, but must meet course prerequisites, as long as the student completes the TSI waiver form prior to enrollment.
